Über GOLIF.

Wir freuen uns unglaublich, ihn in unserer Galerie zu haben, denn als wir seine Bilder entdeckten, waren wir gleich hin und weg. Die Mischung aus urbaner Lässigkeit und gleichzeitiger visueller Kraft machen seine Arbeiten für uns zu absoluten Highlights.

Seine Figuren und Gesichter erinnern in ihrer klaren Strichführung an klassische US-amerikanische Graphic Novels – und sie sind inzwischen Teil des Wiener Stadtbildes. So findet man seine Arbeiten z.B. bei der Falcostiege, am Hernalser Gürtel, bis vor kurzem auf dem Mariahilfer Gürtel, auf dem Naschmarkt, an der Marx Halle oder auf einem Getreidespeicher in Korneuburg, um nur einige zu nennen. Für Aufsehen sorgte vor einigen Jahren sein riesiges – temporäres – Bodengraffiti „Der Beobachter“ in Neu Marx. Auf dem ehemaligen Areal der Stadtwerke entstand ein Werk mit der Größe von sechs (!) Fußballfeldern.

GOLIF stammt ursprünglich aus einem kleinen Dorf in Tirol, erlernte den ehrenhaften Beruf des Vergolders, Schilder- und Illusionsmalers, zog dann aber nach Wien, wo er an der „Angewandten“ Druckgrafik studierte. Obwohl seine Arbeiten im öffentlichen Raum stattfinden und er selbst sagt, „Es brennt in mir, die Stadt zu verändern“, sieht er sich selber nicht als Street Artist, sondern als klassischen Künstler, der Skulptur, Grafik und Malerei verbindet.

GOLIF, Jahrgang 1984, lebt und arbeitet in Wien.

About GOLIF.

We are incredibly happy to have him in our gallery, because when we discovered his works, we were immediately blown away. The mixture of urban cool paired with strong visual power makes his works absolute highlights for us.

The clear lines of his figures and faces are reminiscent of classic US graphic novels - and they have become part of Vienna's cityscape. You can find his works at the Falcostiege, at the Hernalser Gürtel, until recently on the Mariahilfer Gürtel, at the Naschmarkt, at the Marx Halle or on a grain silo in Korneuburg, to name but a few. A few years ago, his huge - temporary - floor graffiti "The Observer" in Neu Marx caused a sensation. A work the size of six (!) football fields was created on the former site of the municipal utility.

GOLIF originally comes from a small village in Tyrol, learned the honourable profession of gilder, sign and illusion painter, but then moved to Vienna where he studied printmaking at the "Angewandte". Although his works take place in public spaces and he himself says, "It burns in me to transform the city", he does not see himself as a street artist, but as a classical artist who combines sculpture, graphics and painting.

GOLIF, born 1984, lives and works in Vienna.


