

Über markus_o_mod.

„Think small“ – diesem Motto hat sich der Kölner Künstler Markus Oechelhaeuser alias markus_o_mod verschrieben: Momentaufnahmen von Street Art-Werken und urbanen Szenen hält er in umwerfend realistischen 3D-Modellen fest, die er in Handarbeit selber fertigt. Jetzt stellt er seine Arbeiten erstmals in der Take a Butcher's Gallery aus.

Markus_o_mod ist ein Street Art-Fan der ganz besonderen Art. Denn ihm reicht es nicht nur, mit Kamera bewaffnet durch die Stadt zu ziehen und Fotos von urbaner Kunst zu schießen. Er nutzt seine Bilder – oder auch Bilder der Künstler – als Vorlage, um sie in 3D im Maßstab 1:20 oder 1:10 nachzubilden. Ob ein Stromkasten mit Paste-up, ein rostiger Tank mit einem Graffiti-Spray oder die Fassade des Kölner Kult-Klubs „Roxy“: Jedes Werk besticht durch absolute Originaltreue bis ins kleinste Detail.

Dadurch verändert er auch die Sichtweise des Betrachters: Denn was wir im Alltag oft gar nicht (mehr) wahrnehmen, kommt erst durch die Verkleinerung zum Vorschein und rückt ins Bewusstsein. Da ist der verblasste Sticker an der Dachrinne, die Schönheit von Rost an einer Eisentür, das Unkraut, das sich durch den Asphalt kämpft. Als Beobachter fängt markus_o_mod die kleinen und großen Dynamiken des urbanen Raums ein und macht sie sichtbar.

Gleichzeitig sind seine Arbeiten eine Hommage an die Vielfalt der Urban Art-Szene. Ob Tags, Sticker, Sprays oder Paste-ups: Jedes Werk wird mit Akribie und mit größtem Respekt gegenüber dem Original im kleinen Maßstab reproduziert – überwiegend in Handarbeit mit Pinsel und Farbe. Für manche Stencil-Arbeiten fertigt er sogar Sprühschablonen in XXXS an. Natürlich agiert er stets mit dem Einverständnis der Künstlerinnen und Künstler. Dazu zählen bekannte Namen wie Seileise, Maidincologne, das Kollektiv Levveunlevvelosse, Greentaxonomy, Hallokarlo, Lapizgraffiti, Liz_art_berlin, Neal_hamburg, nort_oner, Plotbot Ken oder r.f.art.

Ebenso beeindruckend wie die Arbeiten selber ist der Weg dorthin. Denn markus_o_mod fertigt alle Teile selber – „full scratch“, wie es in der Modellbau-Szene heißt. Sein Handwerkszeug sind dabei der Blick fürs Besondere im Alltäglichen, verschiedenste Materialien wie z.B. Kunststoff, Metall, Holz und Gips, sowie für die Herstellung spezieller Bauteile ein CAD-Programm und ein 3D-Drucker – plus viel Geduld und Beharrlichkeit, um den perfekten Effekt zu erreichen. Er experimentiert mit Materialien, Farben und Farbmischungen, entwirft und verwirft, bis das Endergebnis 100% dem Original entspricht.

Die Vernissage von „XXXS – Urban Snapshots Re-modelled“ findet statt am 17.09.2021 von 18.00–22.00 Uhr. Die Ausstellung läuft bis 31.10.2021.

About markus_o_mod.

"Think small" – Cologne-based artist Markus Oechelhaeuser aka markus_o_mod has dedicated himself to this motto: He captures snapshots of street art works and urban scenes and turns them into stunningly realistic 3D models that he handcrafts himself. We are extremely proud to be the very first gallery to exhibit his work to the wider world.

Markus_o_mod is a street art fan of a very special kind. For him, it's not enough to just roam the streets armed with a camera and take photos of urban art. He uses his pictures – or pictures taken by the artists – as references to then replicate them in 3-D on a scale of 1:20 or 1:10. Whether it's an electricity box with a paste-up, a rusty tank with a graffiti spray, or the facade of Cologne's cult club 'Roxy'; each work impresses with its' breathtaking truth to the original, down to the smallest of details.

And through this, he changes our way of seeing: what we often don't even notice (anymore) in everyday life comes to light and to our attention because of this miniaturization. There is the faded sticker on the gutter, the beauty of rust on an iron door, the weeds struggling through the asphalt. As an observer, markus_o_mod captures the small and large dynamics of urban space and makes them visible.

At the same time, his works are a tribute to the diversity of the urban art scene. Whether tags, stickers, sprays or paste-ups: each work is reproduced on a minute scale with meticulous detail and the utmost respect for the original – predominantly by hand with brush and paint. For some stencil reproductions, he even hand-cut stencils in XXXS. Of course, he always acts with the consent of the featured artists. These include well-known names such as Seileise, Maidincologne, the Levveunlevvelosse collective, Greentaxonomy, Hallokarlo, Lapizgraffiti, Liz_art_berlin, Neal_hamburg, nort_oner, Plotbot Ken or r.f.art.

Just as exciting as the works themselves is the process of getting there, because markus_o_mod makes all the parts himself ('full scratch' is the term used in the model-making community). His tools of the trade are an eye for the unusual in the everyday, a wide variety of materials such as plastic, metal, wood and plaster, as well as a CAD programme and a 3-D printer for the production of special components – and a lot of patience and perseverance to achieve the perfect result. He experiments with materials, colours and colour mixtures, designs and discards, until the final result is 100% like the original.

The opening of "XXXS – Urban Snapshots Re-modelled" will take place on 17.09.2021 from 18.00–22.00. The exhibition runs until 31.10.2021.










